## **Officer Reports:**

**Safety Officer:** Present. Sam C gave a narrative of his dead battery incident at the Capitol City RC Club's October 2<sup>nd</sup> Fly-In. Several members shared some of their experiences as well. Once again, check that your electrical components are in good condition and that your battery is fully charged before you fly. In fact, you should check your battery every time before flying. Sam did not and the incident ensued. Also, do not taxi into the pit area unless your plane is turned off. Complacency can lead to serious consequences.

**New Business:** Some additional comments about the Club's recent Big Bird Fly-In. Registered pilots should eat lunch first to keep the show going. It was also mentioned that we should have two members at the Registration Table to handle some of the tasks. It would allow those members to have a break and be able to fly their planes as well. Mention made that there should be more commentary through the PA system during the show.

President Mark has made arrangements for the monthly Club meetings from November through April at the Kansas National Guard Museum. Mark also announced that nominations for Club President and Treasurer will be made at the November meeting with the election held at the December meeting.

Greg Inkmann thanked the Club members for attending the Foundation for Aeronautical Education's (FAE) October 8th Fly-In.

Vernon made mention of possibly adding a rubber mat section to the runway at the Blue Sky Aerodrome for smaller aircraft to take off and land on. Sam C mentioned seeing a recent article in AMA's Model Aviation magazine he will try to locate and bring to the next meeting.

Mention made of possibly changing the type of grass on the runway, perhaps to Bermuda.

Bill Miller announced that the field restroom plumbing will be winterized and shut down for the season today.
